President Young asked if there were any other nominations. He then asked an additional three times. There were no other nominations for Village Trustee. Hearing none, Young announced that the nominations for Village Trustee were closed.

Young announced the candidate names for Village Trustee.

Mike Murray motioned to adjourn the Caucus, seconded by Nikki Gilbertson. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
